Senior Patrol Leader Report: Greg Ohlemacher (SPL) reported:

1. **Upcoming campouts and meetings:** (The current schedule will be on the website.)
2. **Mon, July 30, Family Picnic and Ice Cream Social:** Assignments: Panthers and Cougars, drinks; Eagles and Diablos, assorted desserts; Llamas, ice cream toppings; and Adults, ice cream. Large municipal park shelter to be reserved for \$50.
3. **August 17-19:** Wilderness Survival and Pioneering at Camp Oyo.
4. **Mon, Aug 27, Iron Chef Troop Meeting at Carlisle's:** SPL and ASPL's to organize. Chuck beef and dessert menu.
5. **Eagle Feather:** Keith Crook and Greg Carlisle have applications, but they may not have applied.

6. **Summer Camp 2008 Report:** A handout, listing 4 camps, was distributed and presented by Kevin Colvin. The PLC favored Camp Crooked Creak, near Clermont, south of Louisville, KY. Troy had some other suggestions. More information was requested before this year's summer camp.
7. **Planning Campout in November:** We should try for Camp Joy of Living, north of Brinkhaven, on the Mohican, in Knox County. An alternate is the Exchange Lodge at Camp Lazarus.
8. **Elephant Ball** at Ridgewood Elementary on 6/25 was awesome. Great turnout.

Scoutmaster Report: Dave Thornton did not discuss any separate topics but had input on various items.

Committee Reports

Quartermaster and Equipment: Tents need to be inspected.

Advancement: Sheryl distributed troop merit badge counselor list. Mark Daniels emailed on 6/9 the district counselor list. Sheryl will be a counselor for Family Life, Karl for Personal Fitness. Sheryl suggested that some merit badge counselor links be put on the website. She will contact the troop counselors to see if they want to remain on the list. After summer camp, we will try to enlist more local counselors.

Outdoor Activities & High Adventure: See reports in previous sections.

Greenery Sales: No report.

Membership: Transfer membership processing from Dave to Phil. Also, committee chair from Vince to Karl.

Old Business

Katrina Cheque: Cheque for Katrina Relief from penny wars is still not cashed. Trying to contact council office.

Training: Youth Protection Training is online at <http://olc.scouting.org/info/ypt.html>. This is required every year for all adult leaders. If an adult leader's membership number is entered, his record will be updated. Turn in completion certificate for all ASM's and committee members who complete.

Gas Reimbursement: Discussion continued concerning a gas surcharge for longer trips. This would be part of the campout fee and could be distributed to drivers and for pulling the trailer and possibly for transporting scouts or equipment. Recently, \$5 was added to the Lake Erie campout fee with a total of \$120 collected for the fund; Dave Hooper has not yet been compensated for pulling the trailer to recent Lake Erie campout. Payment might be based on a certain amount per mile or the cost of gas used during the trip. A fund would be built up for pulling the trailer. **Motion: to reimburse drivers for pulling the trailer based on gas used per receipt. (Thornton, Brown) Passed.**

Camping Hours: Need to be turned into Mark Hilligoss for recent campouts.

New Business

Troop Accounts: Inactive accounts need to be identified and placed in camper scholarship fund. Tabled.

Name Tags: New name tags are needed – either cloth tags or black name tags. Troy will investigate options and cost, possibly online at Class B. Lois suggested a meeting on sewing.

Nagatamen Training: See SPL report on Eagle Feather.

Merit Badge Counselors: Counselors need to be recruited and the list needs to be updated. Mrs. Ireland has volunteered for Family Life and Personal Fitness. Check with Dan Dimitrovski to see if he should be removed from the list. Phil Rosen volunteered for Cycling. Troy indicated Mr. Carter might do Waterskiing this summer for a few scouts. A "Merit Badge College" might be a good idea for next year.
